

# Cookie Policy

## What is a cookie?

Cookie is a small text file contains information about a user's activity on a website and stores it on the device used to access that website. Cookies do not damage your device and allow us to offer you a better browsing experience and faster responsiveness on our website. We recommend that you carefully read the following information to better understand what type of cookies we use and how you can customize their use, based on your preferences.

## Which cookies does our website use?

Our site only uses strictly necessary cookies (which do not require your prior consent): They are needed for the functioning of the website, in particular, to carry out operations such as the provision of services you request on the website, the recording of your preferences ( for example, cookie preferences) and maintaining access to your registered account. To guarantee the correct functioning of these cookies and ensure that your preferences are recorded, these cookies will not be deleted at the end of navigation. These cookies will have a period of validity (not exceeding 2 years) after which they will be automatically deactivated. These cookies and the information transmitted by them will not be used for purposes other than those described above. The installation of strictly necessary cookies does not require your prior consent: we set them automatically on your device when you access the website or make specific choices on the site (for example, when you select your cookie preferences, or click on the "Remember me" option). You can decide to deactivate these cookies at any time through the Privacy Preference Center (more information on this is provided below).
