What are your rights?

As an interested party, you have the right of access, rectification, cancellation, limitation, opposition and portability. You can revoke any consent given at any time and also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the State of residence.

How you can revoke your consent and lodge a complaint?

As an interested party, you can revoke any consent given at any time and also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the State of residence.

Which data are necessary?

The provision of personal data and contact data, navigation data, data acquired through cookies is mandatory. The consequences for failure to provide are: Inability to use the site or obtain the requested commercial information.

Which data are optional?

The provision of data Bank details, billing data, data provided voluntarily by the user is optional. The consequences for failure to provide are: Inability to obtain more in-depth information.
